Self Guided Discovery may be suitable for:

Customised Employment using Self Guided Discovery is an effective way for self determined individuals and families to pursue employment opportunities that may lead to open employment, part time employment or self employment. The Discovery process can also be used to support NDIS planning meetings and when applying for SLES funding.

Delivered in two sessions, this training will support knowledge and skills acquisition through face to face learning and hands on practice. Participants must attend both sessions.

You will learn;

- The Critical Elements of Customised Employment and Discovering Personal Genius
- Essential Discovery Activities that elicit Skills, Tasks, Ideal Conditions of Employment and Personal Attributes
- Determining Vocational Themes
- Discovery and Job Development Strategies
- Strategies for Engaging with Employers
- Engaging with Planners

The program is delivered over two, two day sessions one month apart to allow for immersion in the material and reflection. You will be supported by The Centre for Disability Employment Research and Practice (CDERP) staff backed by our technical partners; Griffin Hammis Associates - the world leaders in Customised Employment.

Cost: \$400 includes full tuition, certificate, fieldwork, post event support and materials that support your journey. This course is not suitable for employment consultants. We recommend more rigorous training for professional employment staff.
